



Application Form for Travel Grant to ISSBD 2022 Pre-Conference Workshops

Please note that travel grants will only be considered for individuals whose academic contribution to the ISSBD 2022 conference (e.g., poster, paper) is accepted for presentation. Travel awards will be made after decisions about acceptances are announced by the organizers of ISSBD 2022 (estimated to be around January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022). Early career scholars with a travel grant must attend one of the pre-conference workshops.

Eligibility: Applicant must be in a PhD program or within 7 years of having received a PhD (late 2015 or later) and be a current ISSBD member.
